



Rules of Eligibility for Crews entering the European Surf Rowing Championship

- 1) The nation that the rowers represent must be a member of a European sovereign state.
- 2) A rower must be a citizen of the country they are representing or
- 3) A rower must be resident in the country they are representing (place of primary residence) or
- 4) All four rowers must satisfy one of 2, 3, or 4 for the nation they are entered under
- 5) All four rowers must be entered under the same nation.
- 6) All four rowers must be fully paid up members of the ESRF by the first day of the competition.
- 7) Rowers can be members of the ESRF as long as they satisfy item 2, 3 or 4 and subject to the payment of membership fees by the first day of the competition.
- 8) In the interests of safety and a successful competition any sweep from any nation, including outside of the EU, will be permitted to sweep a crew or crews in the ESRC whose ability fits the conditions of the event.

Definitions

Citizen – In accordance with the rules for citizenship as set out by the country on the entry form

Primary residence – Defined as the country where the rower resides for more than 200 days a calendar year
